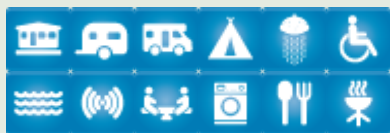

Coming back to Ocean shores, climbing and descending over the technical Coolamon Scenic extension back to Mullumbimby, through the Myocum countryside before returning to celebrate your finish in Byron Bay.
